<p>Art. 17 - Submission of the Memorials</p> <p>a. All teams, excluding the teams participating in the National or Regional Rounds, must submit their three (3) Memorials for each role by email before 10am CET on 26 February 2018.</p>	<p>Late delivery: 20 penalty points applied once to total score</p>	
<p>Art. 18 - Identification in Memorials</p> <p>a. Each team must omit the following references in their Memorials:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. names of team members; 2. the members' and/or the university's country of residence; 3. its nationality; and 4. its university. 	<p>Violations: up to 40 penalty points</p>	
<p>Art. 19 - Memorial Format</p> <p>a. Each team must submit its Memorial in both Microsoft Word and Pdf format;</p> <p>b. Each team must submit its Memorials in size 12 Times New Roman font style – applied to all pages of the memorial;</p> <p>c. Each page shall have a margin of at least 2 cm on every side of the text;</p> <p>d. Memorials must be continuously page-numbered.</p>	<p>1 penalty point per violation. 4 penalty points maximum. More than one violation of the same item of this Article should be considered as one violation in total.</p>	
<p>Art. 20 – Spacing</p> <p>a. The text of the Memorial must be 1.5 spaced;</p> <p>b. Headings and subheadings of more than one line in length must be single spaced.</p>	<p>1 penalty point per violation, 2 penalty points maximum. More than one violation of the same item of this Article should be considered as one violation in total.</p>	
<p>Art. 21 - Word Limit</p> <p>Each Memorial must not exceed 10.000 words (including footnotes). The 10.000 words include the Statement of facts, Issues, Summary of arguments, Written arguments, Submissions and (optional) Annexes.</p>	<p>5 penalty points per 400 words above limit.</p>

<p>Art. 22 - Order of Content</p> <p>a. Each Memorial shall be presented in the following order:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Front cover; 2. Title page; 3. Table of contents; 4. List of abbreviations; 5. Index of authorities (list of sources); 6. Statement of facts; 7. Issues; 8. Summary of arguments; 9. Written arguments; 10. Submissions; 11. Optional: Annex (max two (2) pages); and 12. Back cover. 	<p>2 penalty points per violation. [e.g. Two switched categories counts as a single violation]</p>	
<p>Art. 23 - Front Cover Requirements</p> <p>a. The front cover must contain the following information [No specific order]:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Team number; 2. Role (Defense Counsel, Victims' Counsel or Prosecution); 3. Title of the Competition (ICC Moot Court Competition in the English Language); 4. Year; 5. Total word count. <p>b. The front cover must be colour coded accordingly:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Red for Defense Counsel; 2. Green for Prosecution; 3. Blue for Victims' Counsel. 	<p>1 penalty point per violation. 8 penalty points maximum.</p>	
<p>Art. 24 – Footnotes</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Footnotes are to be in Times New Roman font style, size 10 font, single spaced; b. Spacing between each footnote shall be at least 1.5, or 10 points. c. Consistency in the reference to sources throughout the Memorial is required. A referred-to document should be easy to find using the footnote; d. All the sources included in the index of authorities, must be included in the footnotes as well; e. Footnotes must be uniform; f. Abbreviations of sources within footnotes are allowed. The abbreviation has to be announced in the footnote itself or in the index of authorities. 	<p>1 penalty point per violation. 6 penalty points maximum. More than one violation of the same item of this Article should be considered as one violation in total.</p>	
<p>Art. 26 – Plagiarism</p> <p>Plagiarism in Memorials will be sanctioned with disqualification of the team. A team's disqualification is final and irrevocable.</p>	<p>Disqualification</p>
